Qualifications:

- Students must attend **7 of the 9** Fridays in spring quarter from **2:00 PM – 4:00 PM**:
 - **April 12, April 19, April 26, May 3, May 10, May 17, May 24, May 31, June 7**
- Students will receive one unit of ECON 199RA credit if the above is completed
